# **2022-2023 Program**

- Meetings are held on the second Wednesday of the month from September through June with the
  exception of holidays or House conflicts. (Dates subject to change)
- Members are expected to attend <u>ALL</u> meetings and events. Each member is allowed 2 absences. Absences in
  excess of 2 for any reason will result in immediate dismissal from the Board.
- September (Orientation), December (Trees of Hope event) and March (Dancing Under the Stars). Dates will
  be given during Orientation. Attendance at events is <u>mandatory!</u> Missing any of these activities will result in
  immediate dismissal from the Board.

# **Teen Board (TB) Charter**

# **Purpose**

To serve the families of the Ronald McDonald House of Connecticut, gain leadership and fundraising experience, and serve as ambassadors of RMH in your school and community.

# Composition

The TB shall be comprised of sophomore and junior students from participating area high schools, including home schools. Annually, the TB shall have a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 15 CT members. Students will be chosen based upon prior leadership and service experience by a committee of RMH volunteers and staff. Application materials and interviews will be used to select TB members. Returning members are not guaranteed membership on future Boards.

# **Meeting Structure**

The TB will meet on the second Wednesday of each month from 4-5PM (Date and time subject to change) from September through June with the exception of holidays and House conflicts. In addition, each member commits to lead service activities and attend TB signature events outside of regular meeting times. Missing more than 2 meetings or service activities for any reason will result in immediate dismissal from the Board. Failure to attend the September orientation or the two TB Signature Events (December Trees of Hope and March Dancing Under the Stars) will also result in immediate dismissal from the Board.

### **Overview of Duties**

- Serve as school and community ambassadors for the Ronald McDonald House of Connecticut.
- Prepare and lead service activities for fellow TB members and teens within the community.
- Assist with the planning and execution of the TB signature events.
- Create and execute a "Big Give" fundraising event.

### Responsibilities

- Attend and actively participate in all meetings.
- Come appropriately dressed and prepared for meetings with all required materials.
- Attend TB signature events and chosen service activities.
- Raise funds through "Big Give" projects.
- Embrace opportunities to engage school and community with the House or educate others about RMH.

#### Requirements

- Sophomore or junior high school status during the TB school year.
- Maintain good standing at school.
- No drug or alcohol use and no profanity or inappropriate behavior.
- Attend all meetings and events with safe, reliable, and on-time transportation to and from meeting.

# Ronald McDonald House of Connecticut Teen Board (TB) Volunteer Contract

#### 1. Commitment

- a. A large part of volunteering is commitment. During the school year, TB members are expected to attend ALL meetings and stay for the duration of the meeting.
- b. In addition to meetings, TB members will participate in leadership service activities, signature events, and a personal fundraiser. If you sign up to attend another member's service activity, we expect to see you there! **No-shows will not be tolerated**.
- c. TB members are expected to make their service on the Board a priority. Missing more than 2 meetings or service activities for any reason will result in immediate dismissal from the board. Failure to attend the September orientation, the December or March events will also result in immediate dismissal from the board.

# 2. Etiquette

- a. Every member of the TB has skills, talents and ideas to contribute. Every member is expected to participate in meetings and give their best effort.
- b. Every member of the TB has value and should be treated with respect. There should be no personal attacks—challenge ideas, not people. We are an anti-bullying organization. Every member should contribute to a supportive environment and maintain a positive attitude during meetings, projects and events.
- c. Treat RMH staff, guest families, volunteers and fellow TB members with respect and courtesy.
- d. Exhibit appropriate behaviors at all times—no foul language, texting or other distracting and inappropriate behaviors. Inappropriate behavior may result in immediate dismissal from the board.

# 3. Dress Code

- a. TB members serve as ambassadors of the Ronald McDonald House and should dress in a neat, clean and appropriate manner.
- b. Please wear appropriate clothing to all TB meetings, events and service activities—clothing should provide appropriate body coverage and bear no offensive images or language.
- c. Name tags must be worn at all meetings and events.

# 4. TB Responsibilities

- a. Actively participate in meetings, contribute ideas and provide feedback.
- b. Attend all TB meetings and events—arrive on time and stay to help clean up if needed.
- c. Pursue opportunities within your school and community to engage others in the mission of the Ronald McDonald House of Connecticut.
- d. Organize your leadership service activities to be fun, meaningful and appropriate to engage other teens.
- e. Complete assigned tasks in a timely manner and support your fellow TB members with their assignments.
